

Canadian Accredited Security Contractor (CASC) program – Renewal Declaration

The Canadian Accredited Security Contractor ("CASC") program supports and promotes best practices, ethics, and professionalism in the electronic security industry and enables consumers to find reputable, professional electronic security contractors. CASC accreditation is open to all Canadian electronic security contractor companies that satisfy, on an ongoing basis, the eligibility criteria available online at: www.canasa.org/CANASA/CASC_Pages/Eligibility_criteria.aspx. In order to ensure continued compliance with the CASC eligibility criteria, accredited CASC members must submit completed renewal declarations and, where applicable, the associated fee on an annual basis. Failure to accurately complete and submit this renewal declaration may be considered an attempt to obtain accreditation by fraud or misrepresentation and may result in the denial of and/or delay in processing of accreditation renewal.

	Criteria
a)	CANASA Membership. The Renewal Applicant continues to be a CANASA member in good standing.
b)	Corporate Status . The Renewal Applicant is duly formed, is validly existing, and in good standing under the laws of the jurisdiction of its formation, is registered or otherwise lawfully authorized to carry on business in the Canadian jurisdiction(s) within which it operates, and has full power, capacity and authority to own its assets and to carry on its business as now conducted and to enter into and to perform its obligations under the CASC program.
c)	CASC Representative. The Renewal Applicant designates as its qualified CASC Representative.
d)	Criminal Record. The Renewal Applicant does not employ any individual convicted of, and not been granted a pardon for, any of the offences set out in Table 1 or 2 of the Eligibility to Hold a Licence – Clean Criminal Record, O. Reg. 37/08 enacted under the Ontario Private Security and Investigative Services Act, 2005, SO 2005, c. 34, as amended, available online at http://www.e-laws.gov.on.ca/html/regs/english/elaws-regs-080037 e.htm. The Renewal Applicant must include with this Renewal Declaration (1) updated Criminal Record Checks for all current employees and (2) the names of all former employees who have ceased working for the Renewal Applicant in the 12 months preceding the Effective Date.
e)	Workers' Compensation . The Renewal Applicant continues to comply with all Workers' Compensation legislation applicable in the jurisdiction(s) within which it operates.
f)	Technical Compliance . All field technicians employed by the Renewal Applicant (being those individuals tasked with installation and service responsibilities) have successfully completed, at a minimum, the CANASA Alarm Technician Course Level 1 or an approved equivalent.
g)	Insurance . The Renewal Applicant continues to maintain a minimum of C\$3 million of commercial general liability insurance coverage, including coverage for failure to perform.
h)	CANASA Code of Ethics. The Renewal Applicant continues to adhere fully to the CANASA Code of Ethics.
i)	Sub-Contractors . The Renewal Applicant continues to require and ensure that all sub-contractors retained by the Renewal Applicant are bound by and adhere to the CASC program eligibility requirements.
